

THEBERTON AND EASTBRIDGE PARISH COUNCIL - CEMETERY FEES

Table of fees made by Theberton and Eastbridge Parish Council acting as Burial Authority in respect of Eastbridge Burial Ground.

Due to extremely limited space, automatic permission for burial in Eastbridge Burial Ground will only be granted to residents or ex-residents of Eastbridge or Theberton.

Permission for commemorative benches/plaques/trees/bushes/kerbstone surrounds/etc will not be granted as any spare ground will be required for burial plots. This also eliminates potential problems with maintenance, insurance and litigation claims.

Newly dug graves should be left flat for mowing purposes.

Headstones should be of natural stone rather than black with no surround and should not exceed 3 feet 6 inches in height.

Exclusive right of burial is granted for a period of 99 years in an earthen grave.

There is no designated space to scatter cremated remains.

Fees for a single plot and interment:
